



It's time to take the next step – to attract the necessary upfront financial support for the Life Education Foundation to be a significant and strategic provider of funding to Life Education for the next 10 years.



A refreshed approach to junior primary

The development of 5 new program modules comprising our junior primary school program, which today supports the development of some 250,000 children each year.

The introduction of a unique, customised and highly interactive digital asset that will enable us to effectively demonstrate body systems and functions using augmented reality, and 360 degree viewing – bringing a 3D model of the human body to life in the mobile classroom and amongst students.




Alternative program delivery forums



One of our most popular modules, it engages more than 60,000 children each year.



Helping secondary schools find reality

Developed with the Australian Council for Educational Research (ACER), Reality Now uses a best-practice social norms approach to help schools identify behaviour, attitudes and perceptions in relation to alcohol and other drugs in their schools.

The support provided to Life Education in South Australia at a pivotal time, better enabling it to then successfully present its case to the recently elected SA Government for ongoing financial support.




The Work of Life Education

Growing Reach


The investment from the Foundation has had a significant impact on the capacity of Life Education to grow the delivery of its program – which has increased by 140,000 students pa, or 23% over the 5 year period to June 2017 and we expect to grow by another 14% by 2020.

Community Impact

Evaluations involving data from more than 10,000 Australian students demonstrated, among other things, that the Life Education program plays a valuable role in helping schools to strengthen the capacities in students that predispose them to make safer and healthier choices.

Governance of the Foundation

The Life Education Foundation is a Public Ancillary Fund, established by trust deed, to support programs that educate, equip and encourage people, especially children and young people, to make safer and healthier choices.

The Foundation is registered as a charity with the Australian Charities and Not-for-Profits Commission, and is endorsed by the Australian Tax Office as a Deductible Gift Recipient. Its Trustee is a special purpose company, Life Education Foundation Limited, a company limited by guarantee. The sole member of the Trustee is Life Education Australia.

The Trustee oversees the investment of the Foundation's funds as well as distributions from the Foundation. The Directors of the Trustee are Tony Hasham AM (Chair), Paul Wheelton AM, Christopher Mapp, Paul Siviour, Shaun Bonétt and David Ballhausen.
