- Include bright colours, and pictures to grab attention.

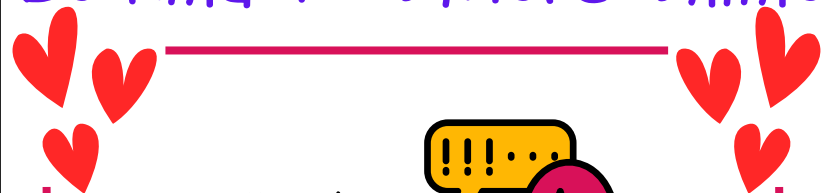
Encouraging Message
